DANIEL T. HOLLAND was born Nov. 4, 1853, at Scranton, Pa. He was the son of Stephen and Ellen Holland. The family came to Troy March 4, 1857. Mr. Holland was educated at the Christian Brothers' Academy and the Bryant, Stratton & Cornell Business College. When quite young Mr. Holland kept newsrooms at No. 299 Fourth Street and at No. 90 Congress Street. He went into business later on with his father, a dealer in picture frames, etc., but in 1870 sold out and began an apprenticeship at the painter's trade with the late John McKanna. He has followed that trade ever since. At present he is associated with C. M. Dorsey, under the firm name of Holland & Dorsey, and they are doing a general painting business. For fifteen years Mr. Holland has been a member of the Y. M. F. M. T. A. B. Society, No. 1, during which time he has held every office in the organization. He is secretary of the Master Painters' and Decorators' Association, and is also secretary of the State organization of his craft. He is a member of the Edward Murphy, Jr., Association, and of the C. B. L., Branch No. 66, of which he is a trustee. He was married Sept. 8, 1878, to Miss Mary J. Farley, and has one child, a daughter, eight years old.
